VASILY PETRENKO Conductor

Vasily Petrenko will become Music Director of the Royal Philharmonic Orchestra (RPO) from August this year. His appointment stands as a major landmark in the Orchestra's history, signalling its determination to broaden the audience for orchestral music while enhancing its reputation as one of the world's most versatile ensembles. Vasily Petrenko made his debut with the RPO at London's Royal Albert Hall in March 2016 delivering a powerful interpretation of Mahler's Symphony No.2, 'Resurrection'. Forthcoming plans include a season-long series featuring the great choral and orchestral works of English composers at both the Southbank Centre's Royal Festival Hall and Royal Albert Hall, as well as tours to the USA and leading European festivals.
